AND WESTFIELD W-LEAGUE ASSISTANT COACH**

AS A PROFESSIONAL footballer, there was no greater feeling than walking on the field at a spectacular stadium as it made you feel like a footballer. Looking at Bankwest Stadium and just getting to feel the atmosphere, the fans are on top of you and noise factor is something else... it is really a very special experience. It adds even more to the occasion when you have a double header with the Westfield W-League and Hyundai A-League teams playing. We have two this season and I think the fans have really taken to them. Double headers allow members and fans to come in early and watch the girls play, allowing them to feel the atmosphere building. It gives the players a massive lift. It's also fantastic see that the Hyundai A-League boys are out watching the girls play before they start getting ready for their game. It is really all about a one club mentality, which we have within this great club now. It's great to see everyone buying into what the Wanderers are all about and we were that from the get go when I was there as the inaugural captain. I really feel we are getting up there where the club belongs and deserves to be.

# MATCH PREVIEW

IT PROMISES TO be an exciting afternoon of football when the Wanderers gear up for their last double header at Bankwest Stadium today.

With both competitions at the half way mark of the season, the Red & Black's sides will play Perth Glory in matches that could define both team's seasons.

The Wanderers will be aiming to collect all six points for the first time in a double header.

The high flying women's outfit will go in as strong favourites against a Glory side struggling near the bottom of the table, while the men's face a stiff test against the defending Premiers.

In his first season in a senior job, head Westfield W-League coach Dean Heffernan has got the team firing and headed for a spot in the Finals for the first time in the club's history.

The Wanderers have been branded as one of the most exciting outfits in the league thanks to their explosive attacking style of football and resolute defence.

There was a slight hiccup last week following a surprise 4-0 loss to Brisbane Roar - the Red & Black's first loss in seven games.

But under Heffernan and his staff, there's no doubt the team will be quick to bounce back from last week's disappointment.

With four games left in the regular season after today, a win is vital if the Wanderers are to keep up the pressure on leaders Melbourne City who have now opened a six-point gap at the top of the table.

The Hyundai A-League side also return to Wanderland for the first time in two weeks following a 2-0 loss away to Wellington Phoenix last Saturday afternoon.

The Red & Black were well in the game against the Kiwis for much of the 90 minutes but luck deserted them in front of goal.

The Wanderers will be hoping to find their mojo in front of goal in a match that would catapult them back into the Top Six with a win.

Currently sitting in eighth spot on 14 points, the Wanderers are just a point behind Melbourne Victory and Adelaide United.

While the results have been disappointing as of late, there is still plenty of football still to be played this season. There are 12 games and 36 points up for grabs after today's fixture - ample time for the Red & Black to make a run for the Finals. **W**

# HEFFERNAN REVOLUTION

FORMER WANDERERS PLAYER DEAN HEFFERNAN HAS TURNED HEADS SINCE HE JUMPED INTO THE W-LEAGUE HOT SEAT

FIVE WINS, ONE draw, one loss and second on the table behind Melbourne City with a game in hand, the Red & Black have been the talk of Australian football with their outstanding and exciting brand of football.

Under the guidance of Dean Heffernan, who is in his first season as a senior coach, and his assistant coaches Michael Beauchamp and Catherine Cannuli, as well as the back-room staff, the transformation from last season's wooden spooners to serious title contenders has been simply eye-opening.

Confidence and belief has understandably soared and that was evidenced in the remarkable 1-0 win over China, ranked 15 in the world, in a friendly on the Gold Coast last week.

During their amazing run, the Wanderers W-League side have also set remarkable benchmarks and created club history, including their best ever start to a season, most wins in a season and record victories over Sydney FC and Canberra United.

Names like Lynn Williams, Kristen Hamilton, Denise O'Sullivan, Abby Smith, Alex Huynh, Sam Staab, Amy Harrison, Kyra Cooney-Cross, Ella Mastrantonio, Erica Halloway and Courtney Nevin are on the lips of the fans.

But, the results are not flukes.

As Heffernan, never one to pat himself on the back, is quick to point out, they

have come about because of the tireless work and dedication from many inside the Wanderers family.

“So much work has gone into it behind the scenes,” said Heffernan.

“Obviously a lot of people only see game day and that is fine, it’s not a problem.

“The bigger the foundation, the higher you go and the more you can achieve and that is definitely something we have always thought about.

“From day one when we got the job, the three of us (Heffernan, Beauchamp and Cannuli) got together straight away ... recruitment, who do we want to keep from last year, who we want to track down, what sort of players we are looking for, what type

of people are we looking for.

“It was a process that took a long time and there were some ups and downs for sure regarding signing players, thinking you have got them and then you don’t.

“We were lucky enough to basically get every player we wanted and that shows the support we have had from not only our staff in the scouting and the time and effort it has taken us to watch games and deciding on players, but also the club, the board, JT (John Tsatsimas) and Gavin, to be there and help us get it over the line as well.

“The thing is, this is our first time coaching in a professional set up like this and I feel like we are doing what we set out to do at the start.

"But, we are always looking at things we can improve on and always reflecting every day after every session 'how could we have done that better' and how we could have got more out of that (training) session for the players."

While Heffernan is supremely proud of his squad and their achievements so far, he is determined to keep their feet firmly planted on the ground. As someone who was a quality professional player, he knows how quickly the football landscape can change.

"We think the key thing here is, we haven't won anything," he said firmly. "We haven't done anything."

"Someone just congratulated us for beating China and I just said 'yeah, but what does it mean?'."

"It doesn't actually give us anything other than the team (exceptional) chemistry and talk about things like confidence and belief."

"We already had that, but now after beating a team 15th in the world, we should have that in spades." ❏

# MILESTONE MASTRANTONIO

ELLA MASTRANTONIO IS SET TO REACH HER 100TH  
WESTFIELD W-LEAGUE MATCH TODAY

IN WHAT HAS been the strongest assembled squad in Wanderers Westfield W-League history signing the likes of US stars Lynn Williams, Kristen Hamilton, Sam Staab, Abby Smith and Irish legend Denise O'Sullivan, no stone has been left unturned in terms of recruitment at the Red & Black this season.

But one that has flown under the radar has been the signing of the ever-reliable and tenacious Ella Mastrantonio.

Mastrantonio, who will play her 100th game in the Westfield W-League against Perth Glory tonight, has flown under the radar in terms of what she has contributed towards the emergence of the Wanderers as a driving force in the Australian women's football landscape.

Mastrantonio is a tireless worker, who is prepared to put her body on the line in every tackle, while she loves nothing better than getting involved in the attack.

Mastrantonio and O'Sullivan have been a midfield rock for the Red & Black this season combining superbly and complementing each other's game.

You would expect nothing less from the Fremantle-born and raised Mastrantonio, who has been a W-League ever present since 2008 when she kicked off her senior career with Perth Glory.

It was during her time with the Glory that the pocket dynamo earned her first cap for the Matildas and has since gone on to earn another five caps.

Mastrantonio's desire to play for her country still burns strong and, on the evidence of her form this season, a recall can't be far away.

From then on she bounced back and forth between Perth and Melbourne Victory, logging up 92 appearances in the national competition.

Mastrantonio linked with the Wanderers at the start of this season and it has been no surprise she has been a regular starter for the Red & Black.

Her attitude and positivity around the group cannot be denied and there's no doubt that Mastrantonio will be going all in tonight's match against Perth Glory not only making more history for the Wanderers but also some history for herself. **W**





# MÜLLER READY TO MAKE MARK

HAVING FINALLY SETTLED INTO LIFE IN WESTERN SYDNEY, NICOLAI MÜLLER HAS HIS SIGHTS SET ON MAKING AN IMPACT AT THE RED & BLACK.

BY HIS OWN admission, Nicolai Müller discovered moving his family to a new country and adapting to a different style of football a little more difficult than he had first imagined.

A 13-season veteran of German football, the attacker decided the time was right to take up a new challenge. Uprooting his family to head to far away Australia to continue his career at the Wanderers.

And, it's a decision he hasn't regretted, even if the few months proved to be an eye-opener as he worked hard to get to peak fitness and fit in with the style of the team.

"My friends and former teammates were surprised. 'Why are you going so far away from Germany?' they asked me," said Müller.

"The coach (Markus Babbel) rang me (about joining the Wanderers). I said this is a good idea, I can do this, I want to do this.

"Then there was a small break, and he called again, and asked again. I talked to my wife and said 'why not'.

"I am happy I did it. I love it here to play, to train and everything is perfect."

The 32-year-old, who is now sporting a brand-new platinum blonde hairstyle, said the conditions in Australia were hard for him to content with initially.

Müller had not played for some time and his fitness needed work. The heat and the hard surfaces were hard for him to content with initially.

"I think before the first three or four games, I needed a bit of time to get used to everything," said Müller.

"The competition, the conditions, it is definitely different to Germany.

"It is a strong league and you need to fight in every game. Nearly every game is 50-50 and you need to have all the little details right.

"The weather, the heat - it is very hot - the air, the hard grounds ... they all make a difference."

After a slow start, the two-time Germany capped Müller, who had stints in the Bundesliga with Mainz 05, Hamburger SV, Eintracht Frankfurt and Hannover 96, has really hit his straps, impressing with his qualities as a leader and an attacker.

Müller scored his first goal for the club against Wellington in Round 9 and followed up with a double against Adelaide United in Round 12 game on Boxing Day.

As well, the German provided an assist for Mitchell Duke to score against Brisbane Roar on New Year's Day.

"I feel now that I am much stronger and I have my confidence," said Müller.

"Everything is perfect now.

"I want to play football, I love football. I am happy and I love the life here. My kids love it and my wife. The city is amazing, it is beautiful."

Müller is confident that the Wanderers can start to make a run for the Finals and he is determined to play a huge part in that.

"We just need to fix the small details. We need to start to make a run, to win games and to get points," explained Müller.

"I feel like I can contribute in that.

"I need to help and I want to help by scoring more goals and having more assists. But we need all the team to work hard together." **W**

# WANDERERS TAKE ON CHINA

## CONFIDENCE AND BELIEF IS SOARING FOR OUR WANDER WOMEN AFTER THEIR HISTORIC WIN OVER CHINA

WANDERERS WESTFIELD W-LEAGUE head coach Dean Heffernan believes his squad will grow even more in belief and confidence after their landmark 1-0 win over China in a friendly in Brisbane last week.

"There was already a lot of confidence and belief in this squad and in themselves. But for them to go out and do what they did

against the team ranked 15th in the world there is going to be so much more belief now, so much more confidence."

The Wanderers did the national competition and Australian women's football proud with their performance.

It has set up the rest of the season for the Red & Black according to Heffernan.

"Every time they walk on the pitch they should know they can compete having outplayed an international team," Heffernan added.

"But, we have to keep our head down, stay humble and keep working hard because that's the minimum for us.

"As long as we work hard and play with energy and effort we know we can win against anyone."

Heffernan said he was able to use every player in the

squad against the Chinese, who he believes were caught by surprise regarding the quality of the Wanderers.

"We didn't ask for any feedback (from the Chinese), but I think they were surprised a little bit," Heffernan said. "They definitely expected to beat us. They didn't and that is good for us.

"The other good thing is that I was able to give every player in the squad a run and even when we made mass changes during the second half, the quality did not drop.

"The full squad got to play and it was easy for them because nothing has changed for us since we walked in the door from day one in terms of our system of play, what we want to do and how we want to go about the games.

"It was easy to put those girls in and we created more chances to score." ❏


