TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By entering the Western Sydney Wanderers FC (WSW) 100 Prizes for 100 Scouts competition you are agreeing to the following Terms & Conditions:

1.0 GENERAL TERMS

- 1.1 Information on how to enter 100 Prizes for 100 Scouts (Competition) and prize details form part of these terms and conditions of entry.
- 1.2 Participation in the Competition constitutes acceptance of these conditions of entry. Entrants must comply with these conditions of entry to be valid.

2.0 PROMOTER'S DETAILS

- 2.1 The promoter is Western Sydney Wanderers FC (ABN 26 156 634 016) of Blacktown International Sportspark, Gate B, Eastern Road, Rooty Hill NSW 2766 (Promoter).

3.0 WHO CAN ENTER

- 3.1 The competition is open to any existing WSW member who refers their friends or family members to sign up for a season 2019/20 membership.
- 3.2 Prior to scouting any new members you must be a financial member of WSW for the 2019/20 season.
- 3.3 You can not sign up to be a new member and scout members at the same time.
- 3.4 If you are a new member, you cannot scout members who became a member before you.
- 3.5 Employees of the Promoter or the Promoter's associated agencies or companies directly involved in the Competition and their immediate family members are ineligible to enter.

4.0 HOW TO ENTER

- 4.1 The Competition commences on Wednesday 24th July 2019 at 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)
- 4.2 The Competition entries closes on Friday 4th October 2019 at 5:00pm AEST.
- 4.3 To enter this competition you must:
 - a. Have a valid 2019/20 season membership with WSW;
 - b. Fill in the form located at www.wanderland.com.au/member-scout

5.0 HOW TO WIN

- 5.1** Any WSW 2019/20 member who has recruited new members in the 2019/20 season and filled out the form at wanderland.com.au/member-scout/ within the Competition period is eligible to win. A new member is any person who did not hold a WSW membership in the 2018/19 season.
- 5.2** Points will be issued to entrants based on the membership type of the new members they recruit; two (2) points for each full season ticketed member recruited, one (1) point for each part-season member, non-ticketed member or W-League member recruited.
- 5.3** Membership is broken down into the following options:
- a.** A full season member is any person who holds a WSW 2019/20 membership in Red, Black, Red & Black, White & Black or Family Zone categories for all 13 Hyundai A-League home matches.
 - b.** A part season member is any person who holds a WSW 2019/20 membership in Red & Black or White & Black categories for three or five Hyundai A-League home matches.
 - c.** A non-ticketed member is any person who holds a WSW 2019/20 membership in Supporter for Out of Town categories.
 - d.** A W-League member is any person who holds a WSW 2019/20 membership for the Westfield W-League season.
- 5.4** A leaderboard will keep track of members scouts based on the points they have earned and will be displayed on wanderland.com.au/member-scout. The leaderboard position at the end of the competition period will indicate what prize has been won. Should more than one (1) member finish the competition on the same number of points, they will be sorted by the order in which they submitted their form (oldest to newest).
- 5.5** The number of winning entries will be the same as the total number of prizes specified.
- 5.6** The leaderboard is final and binding and no correspondence with entrants or any other person will be entered into.
- 5.7** Winners will be contacted via phone and email that is on their membership account on Monday 7th October 2019 between 12:00pm and 5:00pm AEST.

6.0 PRIZE

- 6.1** The following prizes are not transferable:
- a.** LEADERBOARD POSITION 1 TO 10: One (1) intimate function at Bankwest Stadium for the top 10 Member Scouts and the members they have scouted. Members will have an opportunity to meet WSW players, tour the stadium facilities and get a photo on the field of play. Light refreshments will be provided. RRP \$500.00 (AUD) each.
 - b.** LEADERBOARD POSITION 11 TO 23: One (1) exclusive Stadium Tour experience for each scout and the members they have scouted, pre-gates at one (1) Western Sydney Wanderers Hyundai A-League home match at Bankwest Stadium. RRP \$500.00 (AUD) each.
 - c.** LEADERBOARD POSITION 24 TO 36: One (1) opportunity to watch the Western Sydney Wanderers warm-up on field, pre-match at one (1) Hyundai A-League home match at Bankwest Stadium in the 2019/20 season for each Scout and the members they have scouted. RRP \$250.00 (AUD) each.

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- d. LEADERBOARD POSITION 37 TO 56: Opportunity for each Scout to be part of the guard of honour when the players walk out at one (1) Western Sydney Wanderers Hyundai A-League home match at Bankwest Stadium. RRP \$200.00 (AUD) per person.
 - e. LEADERBOARD POSITION 57 TO 76: Opportunity for the Scout and the members they have scouted to have a photo taken on the pitch at one (1) Western Sydney Wanderers Hyundai A-League home match at Bankwest Stadium. RRP \$150.00 (AUD) per person.
 - f. LEADERBOARD POSITION 77 TO 80: One (1) \$150.00 JD Sports voucher for each Scout. RRP \$150.00 (AUD) per person.
 - g. LEADERBOARD POSITION 81 TO 90: One (1) \$100.00 JD Sports voucher for each Scout. RRP \$100.00 (AUD) per person.
 - h. LEADERBOARD POSITION 91 TO 100: One (1) \$50.00 JD Sports voucher for each Scout. RRP \$50.00 (AUD) per person.

Total prize pool is \$1,900.00 in value per person (AUD).

- 6.2 The prize (including any unused portion) must be taken as stated, and is not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash. The Promoter will not be liable in the event that the winning entrant does not take, or is unable to use, the prize or any portion of it for any reason.
- 6.3 Entrants grant the Promoter permission to communicate with them by email and/or telephone in order to provide instructions as to how the winning entrant is to claim the prize and establish his/her entitlement to it.
- 6.4 If the prize is unavailable for reasons beyond the Promoter's control, the Promoter, in its sole discretion reserves the right to substitute the prize with a prize of equal or greater value, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority.

The prize will be deemed unclaimed and the next consecutive leaderboard position holder after position 100 will be given the prize until all spots are filled.

- 8.1 The Promoter and its associated agencies and companies assume no responsibility for any

incorrect or inaccurate information, either caused by an entrant or due to any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in the Competition, or for any technical error, or any combination thereof that may occur in the course of the administration of the competition including any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of entries, and reserves the right to take any action that may be available.
